

Botanical Drawing/Painting Supply List

Below is the list of supplies that your instructor will cover during the Botanical Drawing/painting workshop. ***The items on this list are suggested materials, but you are welcome to bring any drawing/wet media supplies that you already have. You may choose to work in one medium for the entire course, or experiment with different types of medium.***

- Watercolor Set (pan type) - Full or mini size, with a variety of colors in the kit.
- Gouache Set (pan type) - Full or mini size, with a variety of colors in the kit.
- Watercolor brushes (Sable or Synthetic brushes are both acceptable) - Recommended sizes: Round Size 3, Round Size 6, Flat Wash brush Size 8 or 10 or Bright 1/2" brush-You may purchase an assorted pack of round or wash (flat squared) brushes in a variety of sizes from small to large.
- 9" x 12" Watercolor Block - Recommended: Arches White Watercolor Paper Hot Press 140 lb. Hot press will be suitable for pen use, otherwise, the paper may be too rough to work with.
- 14" x 17" Pad of Smooth Bristol Board - Recommended: Strathmore 300 or 400 Series Smooth Bristol Board
- Black ink Fine Nib Pens – Recommended: Sharpie ultra-fine point or Pigma Micron set.
- Colored Drawing Inks (permanent and water based) – there are multi-color sets available, but you can start with a yellow, blue and red, as your three primaries to mix a range of other colors.
- Drawing Pencils - 2B, 4B, and 6B
- Kneaded Eraser
- Roll of 1" white tape
- container with wide opening for water
- Roll of paper towels
