

SUPPLY LIST
WATERCOLOR: FROM Z TO BEYOND
Thursdays, September 12 - November 14, 2019 (No class Oct. 10 - 17)
10:00 am - 12:00 pm

For the first class, please have:

- Watercolor Paint - Professional grade pan or tube paint. Some excellent brands include M. Graham, Winsor & Newton, Grumbacher, Daniel Smith, and DaVinci. At a minimum bring one red, one yellow, and one blue, but you are welcome to bring your basic palette of colors.
- Paper - cold-press watercolor pad or sheets (NOT a block) in the 9" x 12" or 11" x 15" size range; paper should be at least 140 lb. weight. Arches is my favorite paper, but Strathmore, Fabriano and Canson have mid-grade papers that work well. Avoid cheap no-name brands of paper as these will not handle water well and will simply frustrate you.
- Brushes - Feel free to bring an assortment of watercolor brushes, but have at least one round watercolor brush in the size 8 to 14 range and one 1" flat wash brush.
- • Pencil, eraser (I recommend a kneaded eraser), tracing paper and ruler
- Paper towels, or an absorbent rag, or a roll of toilet paper
- A palette for mixing colors
- Two containers for water
